It is usually collected in one pint and used to help multiple patients, by being separated into different components. Plasma is collected through apheresis, which is the process that separates plasma from other blood components. Platelets are also collected through the apheresis process. Once platelets have been selected from the donor's blood, the red blood cells and other fluids are returned to the donor. Double red cell donation is the collection of only red cells through the apheresis process. It allows donors to give double the amount of a whole blood donation. 




